Tammy is a published author and subject matter expert on human trafficking and trauma-responsive care. She has publications featured in the National Library of Medicine (PubMed) and is an international speaker on human trafficking. Tammy's extensive presentation list includes speaking at the United Nations and World Health Organization's Year of the Nurse and Midwife Civil Society Briefing, the National Association of Pediatric Nurse Practitioners - Long Island Chapter, American Nurses Association General Assembly, the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Naples Woman's Club Empowering Woman's Luncheon, and the Bonita-Estero Woman's Club.

Tammy has been retained as an expert witness and a network television panelist. She has been active in her advocacy efforts in Washington, DC. In 2020, A&K Ranch Ministries, LLC, and Nurses United Against Human Trafficking, PA, were founded, and in 2021, Reflective Spaces Ministry became a reality.
